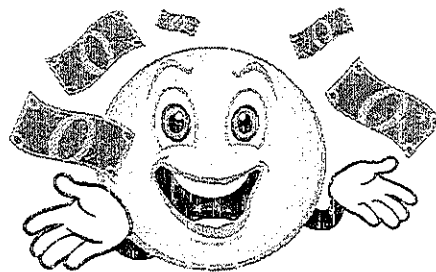

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## **APPLICATION FOR HALE COUNTY FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP**

Hale County Farm Bureau is offering two (2) \$1500.00 scholarships to high school seniors. All Hale County Farm Bureau members or students whose parents or legal guardians have been members for at least one year prior to March 1, 2020 are eligible to apply.

The applicant must be admitted to a College or University or Vocational Technical School the summer or fall of 2020 and show evidence of admission.

Applicant should submit:

1. A complete application form in the Hale County Farm Bureau office by May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020
2. The Scholarship Scholastic Record
3. A copy of High School transcript
4. A double spaced typewritten essay of at least 50 words but no more than 100 words on "My Career Goals and How I Intend to Reach Them."
5. Two letters of recommendation

The completed application forms should be in the above order and stapled in the upper left hand corner. Please do not fold the application. Mail or deliver to:

The recipient will be determined by a committee appointed by Hale County Farm Bureau President and /or the Board of Directors.

The 2020 Scholarship of \$1500.00 will be awarded at the rate of \$750.00 per semester if the student is making acceptable progress according to the standards of the institution in which they are enrolled. The Hale County Farm Bureau reserves the right to terminate the Scholarship if the recipient fails to meet the acceptable standards of the college in attendance and Scholarship Achievements. The student must supply enrollment documentation from the school before payment is made. At the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester the student must show they have met the acceptable G.P.A. standards of the college or trade school they are attending and proof of 2<sup>nd</sup> semester enrollment before the second payment is made.
